They are working closely with BaRay with email premiums and online entry. If the show is cancelled after the closing date, a BaRay processing fee will be charged on all entries.

PCKC is already looking forward to having two Specialties in August 2021 and to celebrating our dogs and spending time with good friends with our traditional potluck and pizza party.
